

Rules of Conduct

“No Fighting ~ No Biting”

The Facilitator of the Yachats Farmers' Market has the right to remove or deny, from point of membership, any vendor whose conduct is disruptive or harmful to the integrity of the Yachats Farmers' Market, its staff, its customers or other vendors.

Disruptive or harmful behavior may be described as but is not limited to:

- An act of aggression against another person or their property
- An act of harassment or intimidation; including hostile communication within the Market
- Unprofessional behavior within the Market
- Negatively affecting the Market atmosphere or reputation
- Misrepresentation of products sold

Failure to abide by these rules of conduct may result in the following actions by the management at the sole discretion of the Yachats Farmers' Market:

Warning - verbal and/or written notice of improper behavior by Coordinator, Board of Review, and/or the Person in Charge.

Suspension - written notice of suspension for specified time period determined by Coordinator, Board of Review, and/or the Person in Charge.

Expulsion - written notice of expulsion from participation in all Market activities by Coordinator, Board of Review, and/or the Person in Charge.

Please cooperate with customers, guests, other vendors, the Coordinator, the Board of Review, and the Person in Charge in order to maintain the harmonious atmosphere and extraordinary appeal of the Yachats Farmers' Market. And always remember...
